



Wednesday, May 13

Explore Island of Rhodes

We arrive on the Greek island and city of Rhodes at 7 am. Optional excursions include beautiful beaches and the city's old town, which features the medieval Street of the Knights and the castle-like palace of the Grand Masters. The cruise ship departs at 6 pm.

Thursday, May 14

Tour Island of Crete

This morning, we dock at Crete, the largest and the most rugged of the Greek islands. Take a tour to Heraklion and the fantastic ruins of the Palace of Knossos. Our ship departs at noon for the island of Santorini, perhaps the most breathtaking of all the Greek Islands. Our ship departs Santorini at 9:30 pm to arrive Athens the next morning.

Tour Vatican City

After an early breakfast we go first to Vatican City for VIP access to the Basilica of St. Peter and Vatican Museums. Then on to The Abbey of the Three Fountains, the traditional site of Paul's martyrdom; the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls; and Paul's Tomb.



Sunday, May 17

Walking tour of Roman Forum

A walking tour of the ancient Roman Forum takes us to the Arch of Titus which commemorated the sack of Jerusalem by Titus in AD 70; the Mamertine Prison, where tradition says the Apostle Paul was imprisoned; and of course the Coliseum, where thousands of people and animals perished during gladiatorial games. The rest of the day will be at your leisure.

Thursday, May 7

Flight from Houston to Athens, Greece

Saturday, May 9

Sunday, May 10

Tour of Corinth

We travel coach to the city of Corinth, where early Christians received Paul's letters to the Corinthians. Here we will see the pillars, steps, and places where Paul preached as well as worship with a devotional and communion in the midst of the ruins. We return to Athens and enjoy dinner on our own.

Monday, May 11

Cruise to Mykonos

We set sail on a four-night cruise, embarking first for the beautiful Isle of Mykonos, arriving at 6 pm. Choose to spend the evening on the boat or disembark to explore the local scene. Mykonos is one of the Mediterranean's most famous tourist destinations, well known for its beaches and turquoise water. At 11 pm, we depart for Kusadasi, Turkey.



Tuesday, May 12

Tour of Ephesus

A guided, morning excursion to Ephesus includes the Temple of Artemis, one of the Seven Wonders of the World, House of Mary as well as other ancient sites in this biblical city. We depart at 1 pm for the Isle of Patmos, where John received and recorded his Book of Revelation, the last book of the New Testament.
